COMMERCIAL ITEM DESCRIPTION

RELAYS, ELECTROMAGNETIC, RELAY MODULE EXTRACTION TOOL

The General Services Administration has authorized the use of this commercial item description (CID) as a replacement for "Relays, Electromagnetic, Relay Extraction Tool" of MIL-PRF-6106/31 for all federal agencies.


1. SCOPE. This CID covers the general requirements for an extraction tool for electromagnetic relays. The extraction tool for electromagnetic relays covered by this CID are intended for commercial/industrial applications.
2. CLASSIFICATION/PART OR IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (PIN). This CID uses a classification system which is included in the Part Identification Number (PIN) as shown in the following example (see 7.1).

3. SALIENT CHARACTERISTICS.

3.1 Interface and physical dimensions. . An extraction tool for electromagnetic relays supplied to this CID shall be as specified herein (see figure 1).

3.2 Material: Nonconductive. Acetal thermoplastic has been considered acceptable.

3.3 Capability: The extraction tool for electromagnetic relays shall be capable of removing relays from relay bracket mount, MIL-DTL-12883/53.

3.3 Marking. An extraction tool for electromagnetic relays supplied to this CID shall be marked with the manufacturer's (MFR's) standard commercial PIN. The part number marked on the unit pack shall be the CID PIN.

4. REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS.

4.1 Recycled/recovered materials. The offeror/contractor is encouraged to use recovered materials to the maximum extent practicable, in accordance with paragraph 23.403 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR).

5. PRODUCT CONFORMANCE PROVISIONS.

5.1 Product conformance. The products provided shall meet the salient characteristics of this CID, conform to the producer's own drawings, specifications, standards, and quality assurance practices, and be the same product offered for sale in the commercial market. The Government reserves the right to require proof of such conformance.

6. PACKAGING.

6.1 Preservation, packing, and marking. Preservation, packing, and marking shall be as specified in the contract or order.

7. NOTES.

7.1 PIN. The PIN should be used for Government purposes to buy commercial products to this CID. See section 2 for PIN format example.

7.2 Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) code. For ordering purposes, inventory control, and submission of this extraction tool for electromagnetic relays to DSCC under the Military Parts Control Advisory Group (MPCAG) evaluation program, CAGE code 58536 should be used.

7.3 Source of documents.

7.4 Ordering data. The contract or order should specify the following:

- a. CID document number, revision, and CID PIN.
- b. Product conformance provisions.
- c. Packaging requirements.

7.5 Commercial products. As part of the market analysis and research effort, this CID was coordinated with the following manufacturers of commercial products. At the time of CID preparation and coordination, this manufacturer was known to have commercial products that would meet the requirements of this CID. (NOTE: This information should not be considered as a list of approved manufacturers or be used to restrict procurement to only the manufacturers shown.)
