

REQUIREMENTS:

Sleeves shall be specified on figure 1.

The sleeves specified herein are a component of the adapter, straight pipe to hose, automotive air brake hose MS39133.

Materials shall conform to formed rod, tempered, half-hard brass as specified in ASTM-B16/B16M.

Finish shall be uncoated.

Tolerances for the compression sleeve, unless otherwise specified, are as follows:

XXX = ± 0.005

XX = ± 0.002

Angles $\pm 2^\circ$

Buttress threads shall be in accordance with FED-STD-H28/14 and ASME-B1.9.

Part or Identifying Number (PIN).
