MEMORANDUM FOR USERS OF SENSITRON QML-19500 PRODUCTS

SUBJECT: Conditional Release for Sensitron's Reworked/Remarketed Semiconductor Axial Diodes,
MIL-PRF-19500M, FSC 5961

On December 9, 2004, DSCC-VQE met with personnel from Sensitron Semiconductor, Deer Park, NY facility to discuss a proposal to allow for the shipment of JAN branded inventory parts marked at an unauthorized facility (SMC) in China. The proposal consisted of reworking/remarketing the subject devices, and performing 100% Electrical and Visual Mechanical screening followed by subgroups A-1, A-2 and B-1 testing.

DSCC-VQE has granted a conditional release for the inventory parts to be reworked and remarketed in their Sensitron Deer Park facility in accordance with the provisions of MIL-PRF-19500M. JAN branded devices cannot be shipped until the testing is reviewed and approved by DSCC-VQE.

VQE will review all required data and traceability documentation before each lot release. A letter will be sent to Sensitron for each lot to grant permission to release and ship product or hold for disposition.
