Re: Notification of Qualification Removal from QPL-28830, FSC 6145; Preparing Activity:
DLA-CC; Control Number 40258, Letter Number: 13-026776

Radio Frequency Systems is listed on QPL-28830 for M28830/3-II, M28830/4-II, and M28830/5-II. It was brought to our attention the M28830/3-II cables cannot consistently meet the VSWR test in the 6-8Ghz range. Additionally, Radio Frequency Systems hasn't responded to DLA Land and Maritime-VQP's questions about the last retention report for M28830/3-II, M28830/4-II, and M28830/5-II cables as described in the email sent on July 17th, 2013. Due to the above stated issues, Radio Frequency Systems has been removed from QPL-28830.

Since Radio Frequency has been non-compliant to MIL-DTL-28830, a GIDEP (Government Industry Data Exchange Program) needs to be issued by Radio Frequency Systems as described in the email sent on July 17th, 2013. Please provide the GIDEP for review and approval to DLA Land and Maritime-VQP by COB on August 16th, 2013.
