Dear Mr Oshiro:

A stop ship of all QML-38535 Class Q and MIL-STD-883 Class M product is effective April 21, 2008. The stop ship includes all work in process, finished goods within Cypress, finished goods from distributors and die sales. Also effective as of this date is a suspension of QML certification for the purpose of processing compliant QML products as currently posted on QPDSIS-38535 for QML Design, Fabrication, Assembly and Test lines. The suspension and stop ship is based upon the emails sent by this office on December 14th and 18th requiring a 45 day response regarding the corrective actions covering the findings of the three DSCC audits (see attached)

The suspension is in effect until successful completion, submission and review of the audit results has been performed. The DSCC audit results are based on site audits for the Santa Clara facility in October of 2006, Minnesota fab in May of 2007 and the Cypress Philippines assembly/test facility in December of 2007. Based upon the written responses, DSCC will determine if further audits are necessary.
