RE: Removal of GI Qualification for No Acceptable CVI Data; MIL-PRF-31032, MIL-PRF-55110; FSC 5998; CAGE Code 38898; VQE-11-022494

This is an official notification that the manufacturer's QML-31032 listing for GI base material has been removed. This Office received notification of a failure for GI product during CVI testing (see letter VQE-11-019736). Failure analysis and corrective actions were not completed as requested. During the previous facility audit, the DLA Land and Maritime audit team requested that acceptable corrective actions and CVI data per paragraph C.5 of MIL-PRF-31032 be submitted in order to retain the GI base material listing. The requested information was not submitted and in a response to the audit (see letter in VQE-11-021875) the manufacturer was informed that removal action would be taken.

Dynamic and Proto Circuits must immediately cease accepting and processing any MIL-PRF-31032 or MIL-PRF-55110 jobs requiring GI base material. In order to be listed on QML-31032 for GI base material, the manufacturer must complete corrective actions for the failure and perform new qualification testing for that product. The manufacturer must adhere to all traceability requirements per paragraph 3.9 of MIL-PRF-31032 for product represented by the removed qualification listing, including documentation, microsections, test specimens and unused coupons.
