Qualifications based on the Danish Defence Acquisition and Logistics Organization approval certificate

A retention report in accordance with paragraph A.4.5.5 of MIL PRF-55110 shall be submitted to this Center by November 30th of each year or loss of qualification may result. The report shall be based on the reporting period above and shall include data from all product built under the current and previous qualification reference numbers, as applicable. The report must also include the group B raw data along with a completed DSCC Form 36W for each qualification reference number listed on QPL-55110. If the manufacturer has no certified production in the reporting period, the manufacturer must indicate this on the completed DSCC Form 36W.

Manufacturers are required to inform this Office within 3 business days if a failure occurs during group B testing, if production of these products is discontinued, or prior to issuance of a GIDEP Alert and/or Problem Advisory on product represented by this qualification. This

qualification shall expire 3 years from the effective date cited above, as indicated by the last 6 digits of the qualification reference number (mmddy). A stop shipment/stop production is effective on the qualification expiration date unless approval is granted by this Office to complete existing contracts.
