A retention report in accordance with paragraph A.4.5.6 of MIL PRF-55110G, Amendment 3 shall be submitted to this Center by September 30 of each year or loss of qualification may result. The report shall be based on the reporting period above and shall include data from all product built under the current and previous qualification reference numbers, as applicable. The report must also include the group B raw data along with a completed DLA Land and Maritime Form 36W for each qualification reference number listed on QPL 55110. If the manufacturer has no certified production in the reporting period, the manufacturer must indicate this on the completed DLA Land and Maritime Form 36W.

Manufacturers are required to inform DLA Land and Maritime VQE within 3 business days if a failure occurs during group B testing, if production of these products is discontinued, or prior to issuance of a GIDEP Alert and/or Problem Advisory on product represented by this qualification. This qualification shall expire 3 years from the effective date cited above, as indicated by the last 6 digits of the qualification reference number (mmddyy). A stop shipment/stop production is effective on the qualification expiration date unless approval is granted by DLA Land and Maritime VQE to complete existing contracts.

Please note that DLA Land and Maritime-VQ requests that all correspondences be submitted to them in electronic format. Examples of this include requests for technical evaluations, qualification and status reports, retention test data and requests for testing authorization (including test plans). In the event that a specific report or document is of very large size (>5 MB) please submit the information via digital media, e.g., cd or dvd.
